CSR Impact Areas: Future Forward Education, Inclusive Economy

Kyndryl in partnership with Common Services Centres (CSC), under the Ministry of Electronics & IT, India, launched **Cyber Rakshak**, a cybersecurity training initiative to equip women in rural and remote areas with new technology skills and help them emerge as Cybersecurity Ambassadors.

The initiative is part of Kyndryl's and CSC's commitment to invest in bold ideas that fuel prosperity and support equitable access to technology-enabled education. Over the course of three years, the program will train more than 100,000 women in rural and remote areas, driving cybersecurity education efforts and growing skillsets across Indian communities. The initiative aims to empower future leaders while extending economic opportunity to women in the world's fastest-growing economy.

Training sessions will be conducted across 500 districts in India through the last mile network of CSC, a flagship program under the Digital India Initiative which provides assisted access to government and public utility services in rural and semi-urban areas.

The coursework, co-developed by Kyndryl and CSC, will enable participants to better address cybersecurity threats in their personal and professional work while spotlighting career opportunities in cybersecurity fields. Participants will gain fundamental cyber knowledge, enhance competencies in existing job roles, and learn about security threats that may impact their livelihoods. A central feature of the program will be to train candidates to become Cybersecurity Ambassadors, individuals who upon program completion will achieve a joint certification from Kyndryl and the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) and can serve as guides to local Internet users as they navigate an increasingly complex threat landscape.

Fly High Scholarship Program

Kyndryl India has collaborated with the Himalayan Institute of Alternatives Ladakh (HIAL) to empower Ladakhi youth with real-world entrepreneurship skills that can solve region-specific problems and support sustainability goals. As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) outreach Kyndryl will support the "HILLs Fellowship in Integrated Mountain Development", HIAL's flagship program. The commitment involves sponsoring students enrolled in the program as well as providing career guidance.

Residents of Ladakh and other Himalayan mountain regions need customized learning approaches and skills to overcome the unique social and environmental challenges native to their environment. The **11-month immersive program** bridges this skills-gap by focusing on hands-on practical learning that builds expertise in specific topics such as environmental studies, sustainable entrepreneurship, responsible tourism, and eco-responsive architecture to help students become social entrepreneurs. This engagement will empower Ladakhi youth with the skills, insights, and training to become social entrepreneurs for their region.



By investing in the education and development of Himalayan youth, Kyndryl is helping build a skilled and innovative workforce that can contribute to India's economic growth. This program will empower these young people to harness their potential and be drivers of sustainable development. The program curriculum differs from the traditional system in its focus on innovation, creativity, and practical learning. We aim to create a young workforce capable of intelligent problem-solving, sustainable living, and independent thought through this program.

Kyndryl Advanced Learning Program

"Kyndryl University" was introduced as an in-house program to address the skills gap challenges we encountered in hiring for technical roles. The courses upskill new hires and existing employees with specialized IT skills, enabling them to adapt swiftly to changing industry and customer expectations.

To boost employability for fresh graduates, and to meet the surging demand for skilled professionals across India, Kyndryl proposed extending access to premium courses to qualifying students at partner public institutions under the Advanced Learning Program

Kyndryl has partnered with National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology) NIELIT) an autonomous scientific society under the administrative control of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MoE&IT), to train 10,000 students under this initiative. PNIELIT is engaged both in formal and non-formal education in IECT, besides the development of industry-oriented quality education and training programs in the state-of-the-art areas.
